

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

COURSE PREREQUISITES

1. Who is eligible for the course?

- Student must have a personal interest to learn and understand the Qur'an.
- Students must have fluency in the English language.
- Both men and Women

2. I want to join this course but I am living outside Sri Lanka. What are my options?

Students are welcome to join us online from anywhere in the world

3. Is there a Listener option in this Course?

No, there is no listener option.

4. I heard about the course late, can I still join? How will I cover the missed lessons?

Yes, late admissions are accepted upon meeting course pre-requisites (see question no.1). The missed recordings will be provided with a deadline to listen to them.

5. What to expect in the course?

Academic Skills

- Correct recitation of the Qur'an with rules of Tajweed
- An understanding of the Qur'an directly in Arabic
- Effective reading, listening, speaking and writing
- Critical analysis skills

Personal Management Skills

- Application of lessons from the Qur'an and Hadith in day to day life
- A positive and balanced attitude towards life
- Honesty, integrity and excellence in character
- Problem solving and decision making skills
- Effective time management
- Self-motivation

Team Skills

- Effective group work skills
- A sense of responsibility and collective purpose

6. Is there a correspondence option in this course?

There is no correspondence option; you are required to be present live in class (Online). However, if you miss a class with a valid reason, recordings will be provided.

7. Is Tajweed a part of the course? If so, how will we be assessed?

Yes. Tajweed is a mandatory component of the course. A teacher will be appointed to listen to your recitation and there will be assessment for Tajweed.

REGISTRATION

1. How do I register? Can I register Online? Or by Mail?

2. When are we supposed to register by?

Starting date of course is on the 10th of February, so ideally before that, registrations are still open even after the course begins.

3. When does the course begin?

The course begins on Saturday, 10th February, 2024, In'shaa Allah.

4. What is the complete duration of the course as well as the days and timings?

Course Duration: Approximately 4 years In sha Allah, February 2024 – February 2028 (Tentatively)
Timings: Every Saturday and Sundays : 7:30 am – 10:00 am [Sri Lanka Time]

5. Is there a specified time each day for course instruction or can a student work at their own pace?

FEES

1. What is the tuition fee of the course?

Local Students : Rs.5000 each month

ATTENDANCE

1. Is attendance required at a physical location to write the exam?

No, exams may be attempted through the student portal within the specified time.

ASSESSMENTS

1. Are there tests or exams? If so, are they written or oral?

The test may be online or oral depending on the subject e.g. Tajwid has both an oral test as well as a written (online) one.

2. Is there active participation required in the course i.e., do I have to interact with instructors/students?

Yes, each student will be assigned a group. Students will review their lessons in that group. Groups will be once a week. Instructors will ask questions pertaining to the Tafsir lesson, and conduct various different activities related to the course material.

GRADUATING

1. In order to obtain the Certificate, am I required to complete all the tests and assignments?

Yes, the student must successfully complete all the required tests and assignments with a passing grade in order to obtain a certificate.

Passing Percentage :-

80% for Tafsir and Tajwid

2. Will diploma of this course be recognized by other Islamic schools to enable me become a teacher or use the credits of this course anywhere?

Not guaranteed.

3. After learning tajwid from this course, will I have the 'Ijazah' [permission certificate to teach tajwid]?

No.
